

The **cougar** also commonly known the mountain lion, or puma. The cougar is an ambush predator and pursues a wide variety of prey. Primary food sources are ungulates, particularly deer but also livestock. It will also hunt species as small as insects and rodents. This cat prefers habitats with dense underbrush and rocky areas for stalking, but can also live in open areas. The cougar is territorial and survives at low population densities. Individual territory sizes depend on terrain, vegetation, abundance of prey. While large, it is not always the apex predator in its range, yielding to the jaguar, gray wolf, American black and grizzly bear. It is reclusive and mostly avoids

people. Fatal attacks on humans are rare, but in North America have been trending upward in recent years as more people enter their territory...information source Wikipedia

It is the continent's smallest and most widely distributed bear species. Black Bears are omnivores with their diets varying greatly depending on season and location. They typically live in largely forested areas, but do leave forests in search of food. Sometimes they become attracted to human communities because of the immediate availability of food. The Back Bear is the world's most common bear species.
