### Membership Committee:

### **Special Orders**

Our special guest Deputy Mayor Ray Frey spoke on behalf of the R.M. of St Clements.

- \$ 8,000.00 of New Grant Money has been awarded for our Beach Access Project.
- \$ 20,000.00 has been set aside from the R.M. for Lakeshore Heights for working and repairing the ditches and drainages for the area.
- The R.M. is also working on getting a Medical Centre with a testing lab and full time doctors for the area, to be opened in the New Grand Marais Community Central building.

### Old Business arising from the Previous Meeting

Cost of our New Bulletin Boards came out to \$782.00, a cost overrun of \$362.82. A motion was made by Judy Gorman to authorize the overrun of funds for the bulletin boards. Seconded by Diane Little... carried.

A big Thank you goes out to Al Tymofichuk and Herb Summerfeldt for the construction of the bulletin Boards, and to Tim Edwards for supplying the drilling equipment.

# **Beach Access Project:**

With our new grant of \$8,000.00 we are continuing with our Beach access project.

The breakdown of work on the project is as follows:

Bldg. Permit \$ 150.00

Materials \$ 3,172.90 including GST and PST

Constr. Cst. \$ 3,885.00 including GST

Geo Tech Engineer \$ 9,920.00 plus taxes of \$170.00 equalling to \$ 10,090.00

Total Cost for the current work is \$17,297.90

Cash on hand \$5,803.75 (\$4,403.50 + \$1,276.25 remaining amount from 2012 grant + \$124.00 obtained on a 50/50 draw + \$8,000.00 grant = \$13,803.75) cash on hand for the project at this time.

We factored in a 10% buffer for the scope of work within the geo tech report......

\$ 10,090.00 additional \$ 1,000.00 to be used for stabilization of the bank.

Currently given the scope of work at hand, our shortfall is \$ 4,444.14.

A motion was made to increase the membership fees from \$10.00 to \$20.00 by Darlene Fissette. Seconded by Libby Powell... Carried.

### Tarp:

The topic of whether a tarp is necessary to act as a wind shelter for the west side of the covered community shelter. Nothing had been resolved to this time. A motion was made by Libby Powell to remove this topic from old business. Seconded by Carol Markiewich.....carried.
