There has been an increase in concern with the following topics:

ATV's; Issues with racing, loud mufflers, making noise late at night, not abiding the road rules etc. Please phone the RCMP. The more complaints, the more results... Dogs in the area; Last summer incidents pertaining to dogs included people being charged while walking or riding bicycle on the roads. Even attacks causing injury to other pets. Being a responsible dog owner means you will provide your dog with the attention and daily exercise it needs and respecting not everyone is comfortable with dogs. If your dog is disturbing your neighbours for any reason, they can file a complaint with the **Animal Services Agency** by calling; **1.204.944.2914** Dog By-Laws apply in cottage country, just like the city.

Full copy of the by-laws can be found on the RM of St.Clements Website under "Local Government" tab then "File-Doc/Bylaws Pg 5" Animal Controls...

Animal By-Law states:

No owner shall: permit dog to run at large, permit a dog in play structure area, permit a dog to go for walk(s) without being on a leash no longer than 6 feet

No owner shall: permit dog to bark or howl or in any other way unduly disturb the quiet of any person or persons anywhere... permit dog to defecate on any public or private property other than the property of its owner. Where a dog defecates on property other than the property of its owner, the owner shall cause such excrement to be removed immediately.

No owner shall: permit a dog to pursue any person or animal or permit a dog to bite or wound any person or animal.

Slow Down... Enjoy the Lake surroundings... Life goes by fast enough.

Every year we receive a lot of speed & traffic complaints. With the area population increase more children out, riding bikes & more people enjoying a walk about the area. Remember the basic rules of the road. Stop at stop signs, obey the speed laws (30 k.p.h. max)...as you never know if a child playing or wild life, can dart out onto the road way.
