President Message Spring 2017

Greeting everyone... This spring was kind to our community. The ice was off the lake much earlier than in previous years. The melt runoff was gradual therefore LakeShoreHeights experienced very little overland flooding. Spring also is a time when our seasonal residents start to open up their summer homes and the hub of LSH comes to life.

As I took a walk about in the community, I reflected upon all of what transpired last summer. Between the Community events and the completed projects, it was a busy one!!! The 2016 summer season events began with the Community Yard Sale, followed by the Family Picnic, Swim Program, Pancake Breakfast, Horseshoe Tournament, Golf Tournament, ending with the newest event, LSH night at a Manitoba Moose Hockey Game.

The community continued to see improvements as numerous projects were completed throughout the summer months. Park benches and a picnic table with seating were purchased thanks to the financial assistance of both the Municipality and your membership fees. The remainder of the projects included, a ramp leading to the community shed, enhancing the walkway with steps down to the volley ball beach, as well as the installation of a Deadman system to further anchor the main beach stair structure.

With perseverance and ongoing contact with the Municipality, one major Public Works related project took place. The brushing of the main ditch that runs from Northshore Road to Road 102, down 102 towards West Street was finally attended too. The next crucial step is in ensuring that Public Works completes the survey to properly grade the main ditch to allow water to drain towards the lake. This is intended to divert rain/snow melt runoffs to alleviate some of the overland flooding experienced by many of our residents.

We invite you to attend the **2017 Annual General Meeting (AGM) on Sunday May 21st @ 11 am** at the Community Covered Structure, located on West St & Lakeview Rd, where the planning of this year's affairs will take place. Your presence is valued, your opinion matters and your votes make a difference.

It goes without saying, that all that's been accomplished within our community would not have occurred without the help of volunteers.
